This is in the form of primary, personal and continuing care to adults and children including those with additional needs and vulnerabilities eg communication difficulties (language barriers or pre verbal), physical and intellectual disabilities, mental health issues and experiences of domestic abuse or other trauma. We have daily contact with children and vulnerable adults necessitating physical examinations. Lakeside Family Practice is committed to safeguarding children and vulnerable adults and they will be accorded equal respect given to all other patients.
